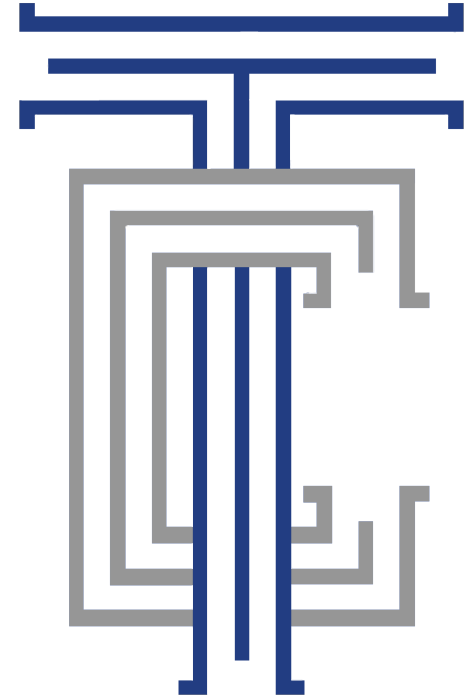

District Student Achievement Goals:

*By June 2021, 72% of all students in each student group, including special program students tested, will pass all portions of the state assessment in reading, math, science, and social studies.

*By June 2021, at least 75% of all students will meet scale score passing rate on state assessments in reading, writing, math, science, and social studies.

*By June 2021, all of ethnicity, socio-economic, and language gaps in the special population program placements will be reduced by 10%

Campus Student Achievement Goals:

*By June 2021, 100% of all ESL and Special Education students will demonstrate a 10% increase in district and state assessment scores.

- Provide STAAR Saturdays for students to practice reading, math, and writing skills.
