2023-2024 School Year Information

<u>Principal</u>: Veronica Maxey <u>Assistant Principal</u>: Allie Bonner

School Day: 8:00 a.m. – 3:45 p.m.

- Doors open at 7:30 a.m.
- School begins, promptly, at 8:00 a.m.
 - O Your student is tardy if they arrive at 8:00am or later.
 - o 3 or more tardies or absences in a 9 weeks will result in a mandatory after-school attendance session for parent and student
 - o Students who arrive on time daily will be rewarded every 9 weeks

Arrival and Dismissal:

- Students may arrive by either bus or parent drop off.
- Bus Transportation: those riding the bus will need to make arrangements with Priority Charter Schools-Temple by completing the form (on campus) or by email (online). Parents may request an application by email and turn in the completed application in person or by email to the campus secretary, Libby Sheard, lsheard@prioritycharterschools.org. **Applications for transportation must be completed every year.**
- Parent drop off is at the front of the school. Students may not be dropped off before 7:30 a.m.
- Student dismissal may occur one of four ways:
 - o TCA Bus
 - o Day Care bus (front pick-up)
 - o Park and Walk up in the front of the school
 - o Car rider pickup in the back (map of new pickup line will be available at a later date)
- You will need to designate the way your child is to get home with the teacher on Meet the Teacher night, August 9, 2023 from 5:00 p.m. 7:00 p.m.

<u>Dress Code</u>: School uniforms are required. We are excited to announce that our district has partnered with Ibiley Uniforms, who will be making polo shirts for our students.

- *Tops*: collared, polo-type shirt ordered from www.ibiley.com. These shirts will have our school logo on them. If students have an old uniform shirt with a patch or vinyl patch on it, they can also wear them.
- *Bottoms*: Docker-type pants, shorts, capri pants, skirts Leggings may be worn under shorts or skirts only. They may not serve as pants
- *Friday only*: denim bottoms with no rips, tears or frays. Tops may be a school spirit shirt, collared polo or college themed shirt.
- *Jackets* must be a plain color and must have a zipper or buttons. Hoodies must be an official school hoodie and should be ordered from the school.

Specials: All elementary and middle school students go to PE. All high school students are required 1 credit.

- To be dressed appropriately for PE, closed-toes shoes/tennis shoes will be needed.
- Shorts or leggings should be worn under skirts

Cafeteria:

• All students are offered a free breakfast and lunch for the 2023-2024 school year. It is their choice whether or not they get one. Breakfast and lunch may be brought from home or purchased.


